She was amongst 31 predominately Mayan Indian students in her graduating class. It was Art's privilege to stand-in for her father and put the class ring on her finger during the graduation ceremony in November. It was an emotional event where grown boys cried and melted into their mother's arms expressing their gratitude for their sacrifice. Dayana, a benefactor of this ministry, is the first in her extended family to receive a high school education and has aspirations to go to university now. We are very proud of her. This is exacerbated by the fact that, for poorer students, time spent in school could be time better spent working to sustain the family. It is especially hard for children living in
