On November 7th, Guatemala was shaken by a 7.4 earthquake. We all felt it and were quite startled, evacuating where we were at the moment it hit. We were under Tsunami warnings, but were spared further damage. The area most affected was the region of San Marcos. We have been in that region many many times throughout the years. *Please pray* for those most affected by the earthquake. Thousands are currently without homes. Fifty-two lives were taken, including ten members of one family. Unfortunately, their holiday will not be as joyful or comfortable as most of ours will be. We appreciate your prayers.





At the end of November, we did an all-day Character First Seminar in Panajachel, Sololá for one of the Credit Unions we have been working with over the last three years. We trained twenty members of their management staff that were not in our original character seminars. We enjoyed working with them and getting to know them throughout the day. We had beautiful views of Lake Atitlán from our meeting room at the hotel. The following day, we drove up the mountain to their home office in San Juan de Argueta, Sololá to continue working with a
