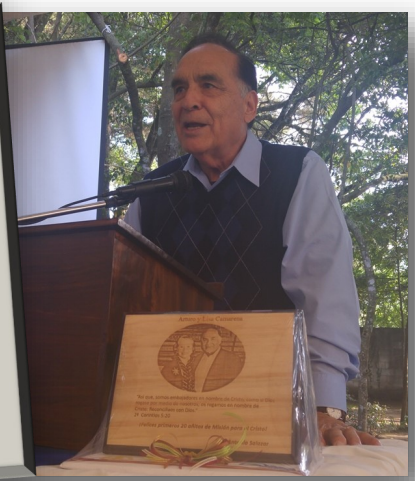

May was a month of events and celebrations. The grand finale was a special event for our 20th Anniversary of Ministry in Guatemala. In 1995, during our first visit to Guatemala, God gave Art a vision of Divine proportion. God showed Art we would be working with the poorest of the poor and yet the wealthiest of the wealthy. He showed him we would work with both Ladino (mixed blood) and Mayan Indian and we would be working with both Protestant and Catholic. Each one of these entities were so far apart from one another. The small wealthy population had little or nothing to do with the impoverished, except to hire them as laborers. The "Ladino" (mostly mixed between Mayan and Spanish blood), looked down on the Mayan Indian and did not socialize with them. In those days, the Catholic and Protestant did not get along. We were told we would be used as a "bridge" to bring entities together. How that would or could happen, would take God's power, not ours. When Art shared this vision with another missionary in Guatemala at that time, the missionary said it would be "impossible". Since we arrived in Guatemala May 18, 1996, we have watched God do the "impossible". This vision became a part of our very beings. It was definitely a vision of God-proportion! We hope you'll take a moment to watch the video and see how it has unfolded.....and continues unfolding. To God be the glory!

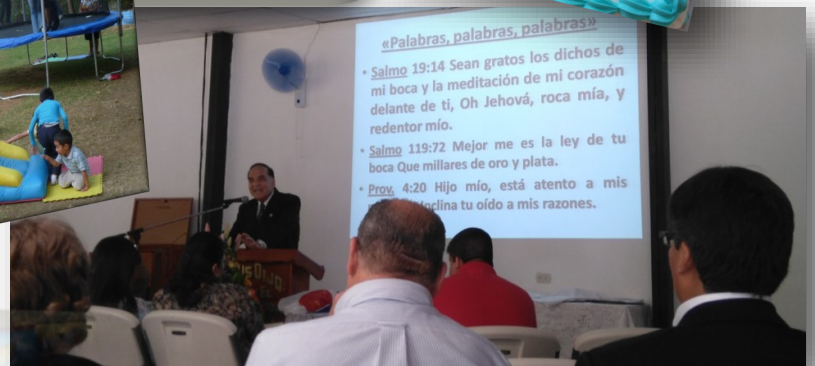
