We hope this finds you well despite the many crises in the world today. We are greatly concerned about the unrest in the United States. Meanwhile, Guatemala's first rain of the new six-month rainy season was Tropical Storm Amanda, causing damage throughout the country. In contrast to the initial deluge we normally receive, the constant drizzle fell for days on end, saturating the land, causing mudslides, rising rivers, and flooding.

At the same time, we are all dealing with various aspects of the COVID-19. We have certainly had much to pray about. Like everyone else, we have made many adjustments. Guatemala has been on quarantine, lockdown, AND absolute curfew during the recent months.



During quarantine, Art has spent many hours cleaning out four storage areas. As a result, he was able to donate over a \$1,000 worth of sound equipment and teaching materials to fellow missionaries in need of those supplies.

As a Third World country, the economy of Guatemala has been immensely affected. Because of travel restrictions and safety, we had to let our ministry employees go and are doing all we can to keep up the grounds, preparing for when the COVID-19 season has passed.

Thanks to generous donations to Ambassadors for Jesus Christ in Guatemala through CTEN, we have facilitated food distribution within and beyond our ministry community. Lisa has kept the Ladies' Bible Study in daily communication. Each week, she motivates the ladies by raffling off free treasures from our storage cleanout. Lisa also has Zoom meetings with her leaders and meets (via Zoom) with her English-speaking Bible study.







*We have had to be creative in implementing our ministry outreaches; distributing food, medicines and the prizes raffled off. We always respect the government-imposed curfews and mandatory mask law.*

Many items have been raffled during the last few months including:

- ◆ four sleeping bags
- ◆ Bedspreads
- ◆ baby seats
- ◆ four pieces of luggage (mostly used for storing clothes)

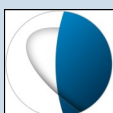
